Dear Chaffee County Major Political Party Chairperson,

The Chaffee County Patriots Ltd are a nonpartisan, nonprofit organization. We are working to ensure the people of Chaffee County are familiar with the candidates and measures that are on the ballot for the 2022 General Election.

We have already had a Town Hall debate with the three candidates running for County Commissioner. On October 14<sup>th</sup>, we will have a Town Hall Open House with the remainder of the candidates who will be on the ballot or who are running as Write-in Candidates.

By now, all registered voters in Chaffee County should have received the 2022 State Ballot Information Booklet. This 110-page booklet contains the statewide measures and the judges who are on retention in our area. It does not contain information for the local measures. The Chaffee County ballot contains approximately 40 candidates and measures that the voters need to vote on.

To help Chaffee County Patriots Ltd educate and inform our community, we are asking that each Major Political Party write 2 – 3 sentences on each measure on the ballot. We understand that not every ballot will have the same measures. It is requested that you state in your answer if the measure is county wide or local. We are also requesting that you write 2-3 sentences on each of your candidates stating why the voter should vote for them.

Since Ballots are mailed out beginning October 17<sup>th</sup>, it is requested that all responses be returned by 5:00 pm on October 14<sup>th</sup>.
